School Games – Athletics

School Games provides training and competitive sports options to elementary, middle, and high school special education students.

It encourages youth participation, inclusion, and leadership in local schools and prepares school age students for participation in SOSC sports opportunities beyond the school day.

MATP – Motor Activities Training Program

MATP is designed for athletes who are unable to participate in official Special Olympics sport competitions. The program is designed to prepare athletes – including those with severe or profound intellectual disability or significant physical disabilities – for sport specific activities appropriate for their ability levels.

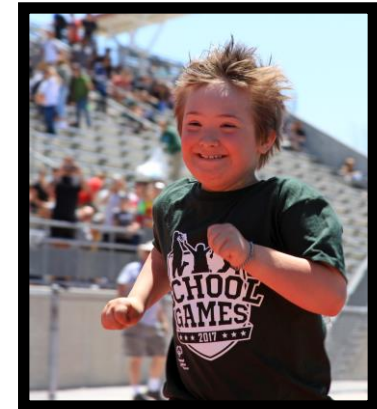
